Jon Sebastian joined the Department of Labor, Office of the Assistant Secretary for Administration and Management in May, 2006 and has served as the Regional Administrator since June, 2012. He is responsible for managing a staff of forty-five providing administrative services to over 2,000 federal employees in a ten state region. His office is responsible for providing a full range of emergency preparedness, facilities, finance, human resources, procurement, safety and health, and telecommunication services, as well as regional policy development. In addition, he serves as an ex-officio member of the Chicago Federal Executive Board having served as Chair in FY2018. He joined Labor in 2006 as the Chief, Staffing and Classification Branch. In March, 2009 he became the Regional Human Resources Officer.

Mr. Sebastian began his career in public service in 1997 as a Presidential Management Intern (Fellow) with the Office of Personnel Management, Chicago Oversight Division, in the role of a Human Resources Evaluator. In 2002 he joined the Environmental Protection Agency, Mid-Continent Ecology Division, in Duluth, MN as an Administrative Specialist and later as a Management and Program Analyst. Mr. Sebastian received his Masters of Public Administration from the University of Minnesota, Hubert H. Humphrey Institute of Public Affairs.
